- **Homelessness** We invite you to help celebrate and equip our Charlotte neighbors transitioning from homelessness into a home. We hope to collect items and deliver Welcome Home Kits. - **Hunger** We would like to deliver a week of groceries to as many Montclaire Elementary School families as we can. We need your help to make this possible. We invite you to purchase one of each of the ten items listed and drop them by the church by Palm Sunday, March 28. No glass items please. We need: bag rice, bag beans, canned meat, peanut butter, saltine crackers, canned veggies, canned fruit, soup, breakfast items, and individually wrapped snacks.
- **Children in Need** Greater Enrichment Program (GEP) at Montclaire is one way we support children in need. We partner with and support GEP at the school to provide afterschool and summer enrichment programming at no cost to parents. During the pandemic, Selwyn invited GEP to provide remote learning support to Montclaire students in our fellowship Hall on Mondays through Wednesdays.
