**2022 PLEDGE UPDATE** Selwyn is close to meeting our budgetary goals for the coming year. A pledge is an estimate of giving for the year. Every pledge is vitally important to support Selwyn's vision and mission. A successful year of stewardship will ensure Selwyn's ability to fund our mission partners at Montclair Elementary school, stabilize our staff, and maintain Selwyn's dynamic worship and intergenerational programming.

Our goal is for at least 130 households to pledge a total of \$780,000. So far, Selwyn has received 93 pledges and \$658,612. Thank you for your faithfulness and generosity! **2021 BUDGET UPDATE** For 2021 Selwyn member Pledges total \$690,000. Goal for pledge receipts through November Year to Date (YTD) are \$632,500. Actual Pledge receipts YTD are \$538,065. Total deficit is \$94,435. As we near the end of the year, thank you to all for satisfying your 2021 giving commitment. It is most appreciated.

If delivered in person, the check must be received in the office by 1pm, December 30, 2021. If mailed, your check must be dated 2021, and your envelope postmarked by December 31, 2021. Checks dated in 2021, but postmarked in 2022 must be credited, for IRS purposes in 2022.
